

Magistrate judge orders superseding indictment S4 against Maduro and others unsealed

What happened

The U.S. Attorney's Office for the Southern District of New York asked by letter that Superseding Indictment S4 in case 11 Cr. 205 be unsealed. The docket lists the order as directed to Nicolás Maduro Moros, Diosdado Cabello Rondón, Ramón Rodríguez Chacín, Cilia Adela Flores de Maduro, Nicolás Ernesto Maduro Guerra and Héctor Rusthenford Guerrero Flores. The document does not describe the contents of the indictment.

What it means

With the order, superseding indictment S4 is no longer sealed. An indictment contains allegations and is not proof of guilt.

What happens next

The document sets no new dates.

Key passages from the filing (verbatim)

"The Government respectfully requests that Superseding Indictment S4 11 Cr. 205 (AKH) be unsealed."

Page 1 — The government's request to unseal indictment S4.
