

Court notice: technical test on December 9, 2022 ahead of the Saab evidentiary hearing

What happened

The court states that its IT personnel will be in courtroom 12-3 on December 9, 2022 at 2:00 PM for one hour to perform connectivity testing before the evidentiary hearing in the case against Alex Nain Saab Moran. The parties may use the courtroom to test their own equipment and that of the locations where remote testimony is expected. The notice reminds the parties that non-attorneys may bring electronic equipment into the courtroom only with a court order, which must be requested by motion.

What it means

This is a routine logistical notice that does not change the charges or dates in the case.

What happens next

The connectivity test is scheduled for December 9, 2022 at 2:00 PM.
