What happened

According to the docket, the form relates to the notice of appeal at entry 47 and orders transcripts of pre-trial proceedings. It was filed by attorneys Lindy K. Keown and David B. Rivkin. The text available from the PDF is a form with blank fields, so these details come from the docket description.

This is a routine administrative step that does not change the charges or dates in the case.

What happens next

The document sets no new dates.
